<p><u>Defiance/Disrespect/ Non-Compliance</u> Student engages in refusal to follow directions, talks back and/or delivers socially rude interactions.</p> <p><u>Physical Aggression</u> Student engages in actions involving serious physical contact where injury may occur (e.g., hitting, punching, hitting with an object, kicking, hair pulling, scratching, etc.). <i>First offense starts at the 2nd tier of discipline.</i></p> <p><u>Disruption</u> Student engages in behavior causing an interruption in a class or activity.
